#### **OUR HISTORY**

The Central Okanagan Bursary and Scholarship Society grew from a need to help young people pursue their education and training beyond secondary school. Several leaders of the educational and business community in the Central Okanagan joined forces to establish the Bursary Society in 1971.

Founding members were Ken Harding of West Kelowna, former KSS administrators Harry Dewar and Lou Dedinsky, and Rosemary King of the School Board office. Thanks to their efforts to galvanize community support for this worthy cause, the number of bursaries, scholarships and awards available to students has grown from seven to over 525 with a distribution of over \$500,000 to deserving local students.

Originally incorporated in 1984, the Central Okanagan Bursary and Scholarship Society is an entirely autonomous body that administers professionally managed funds in trust.
